United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Regional Local Governance Team in Bangkok has developed a “SDGs Local Governance Diagnostic Tool” to support sub-national and local governments and communities prioritise and plan for the SDGs. The “SDGs Local Governance Diagnostic Tool” is based on an innovative approach that aggregates quantitative and qualitative socio-economic data with local governance indicators. In addition, the tool uses crowdsourcing and mobile technology. This diagnostic tool is designed to be self-sustaining and does not require substantial funding. Currently, the tool is piloted in 2-3 Asia-Pacific countries and will subsequently be revised and rolled out to UNDP Country Offices that have shown interest.
